ORIGIN OF REACTANTS

Sethness Caramel Colors are manufactured from highly refined dextrose (glucose) corn syrup (HDGS), liquid cane sucrose, inverted liquid cane sucrose (medium invert), or high fructose corn syrup (HFCS), which are all food grade, meet Food Chemicals Codex requirements, and are processed and packaged in the United States of America (USA).

HDGS and HFCS are derived from (non-segregated) GMO corn that is harvested in the USA.

Cane sucrose and medium invert are derived from cane that is harvested in US Sugar Quota Program Authorized Countries.

Organic cane sucrose is derived from organic cane that is harvested in one or more of the following countries: USA, Paraguay, Argentina, and Brazil.

Sethness Caramel Colors use only the reactants allowed by 21 CFR 73.85 for Caramel. These reactants are food grade, meet Food Chemicals Codex requirements and are processed and packaged in the USA.
